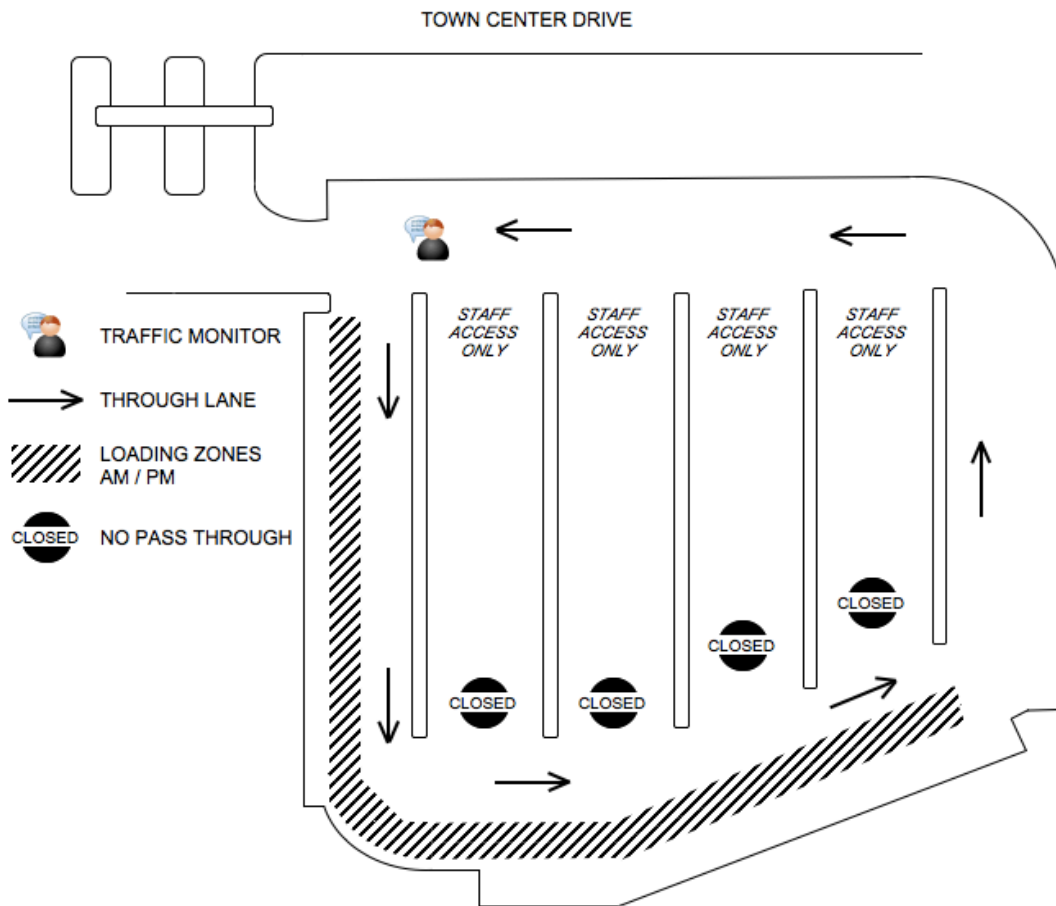


River Ridge Middle/High School Car Loop Procedures



Safety takes patience. Please drive slowly and cautiously.

The River Ridge Complex was built with one way in and out, so please allow plenty of time. We understand that there is a high volume of traffic, and sometimes you will have to wait in line. The traffic monitors and car loop procedures are designed to help keep our students safe and the traffic moving. Please follow this plan and respect the traffic monitors and their directions. Our students learn from your example in traffic.

Students shall only be dropped off or picked up from the right Loading Zone Lane. The left Through Lane allows for traffic to move in and out from the Loading Zone Lane. Students are not to walk between cars or across the parking lot to meet their rides.

- 1.) Pull forward to the next available loading area and pull into the Loading Zone Lane. Encourage your children to enter and exit the vehicle quickly and safely. Once your student has exited the vehicle, signal and re-enter the Through Lane when safe.
- 2.) Keep moving in the Through Lane. Please do not drop off/pick up while in the Through Lane.
- 3.) If you are in line, please stay in your vehicle. If you need to get out of your vehicle, use an available parking space.

IMPORTANT! Do not drop off or pick up students from the Through Lane, entrance gates, bus loop, parking lot aisles, or along Town Center Road. This is unsafe, and it stops traffic. Please be advised that there are signs posted on Town Center Road stating that that stopping is prohibited. Violators will be cited by law enforcement.

In the morning, student supervision begins at 7:00am. School start time is 7:30am. For your child's safety, do not drop off before 7:00am. The school day ends at 1:55pm. Students must be picked up by 2:25pm. Students left unsupervised after 2:25pm will be required to call parents.
