Welcome to the 2016-17 school year! The information below is for students and parents to provide input for student schedules. Students will use this information to choose their elective courses.

Middle School Promotion Requirements

Middle school students are required to successfully complete three years of language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies, as well as a course in career and education planning in order to be promoted to grade 9 [F.S. 1003.4156].

Advanced Coursework:

- Courses will be rigorous and may require significant projects, writing assignments and work outside of class time.
- Placement is determined by past student performance. Criteria will include previous Level 4 or 5 on FSA Reading and/or Math, A average, 70% and above on district quarterly checks and advance placement test as well as teacher recommendation. Notification of course placement and summer assignments will be made in early summer.
- Schedule changes will not be possible once enrolled due to class-size mandates and end-of-course exam requirements.

Engineering Career Academy:

Areas of study include and should be sequenced as 1. Design & Modeling, 2. Automation & Robotics 3. Green Architecture & 4. Energy and the Environment. There are additional engineering courses in high school that continue from this program of study.

How can I earn high school credit while in middle school?

- Advanced classes taught at RRMS that meet high school credit requirements
- High school classes taught at RRHS
- Online classes: Pasco eSchool

PE Requirement: All students are required to take 1 semester of Physical Education in middle school every year (Senate Bill 610). Taking a dance course will also satisfy this requirement.
