Dear Parents/Guardians:

It is hard to believe that the 2015-2016 school year is coming to an end. As we enter the final days, we would like to celebrate this exciting milestone. Please take a moment to read key information that outlines the final activities that your child may participate in prior to transitioning to high school.

Eligibility for Breakfast, Celebration Ceremony, and Parade

In order to be eligible for the June 7th school day activities (breakfast, class video and parade) students must be on track to pass all core subjects. If a student is currently recovering courses through Edgenuity then he or she must have those courses recovered, or be on track to have courses recovered for the end of the year. All final decisions on eligibility will be determined by administration, and will be based on students meeting promotion guidelines.

Breakfast, Celebration Ceremony, and Parade

On Tuesday, June 7, 2016, 8th graders will celebrate their promotion to high school with a special breakfast, class video, and "Last Walk" parade through the RRMS Campus.

We need your baby pictures. Please email one baby picture with one current picture to be included in the 8th grade video. Pictures must be emailed to Mrs. Baumaister cbaumais@pasco.k12.fl.us with the subject line 8th grade baby pictures-student name. Deadline for submission is May 20, 2016. Please see our website or Instagram post for full details.

Families of our 8th grade students are invited to join the parade part of the celebration with balloons and signs at the front sidewalk closest to the parking lot in front of the middle school. The parade will begin at 9:45am and conclude by 10:15am, with the last leg of the parade making its way through the cheering parent section of the front sidewalk. Parents should be lined on the front sidewalk at 9:45am to ensure their participation in the parade. Your child will bring home an early release form 3 weeks prior to the event.
