Middle School Promotion Requirements:

Middle school students are required to successfully complete three years of language arts, math, science, and social studies which must include Civics, as well as a course in career and education planning in order to be promoted to grade 9. [F.S. 1003.4156].

<u>PE</u> <u>Requirement:</u>



- All students are required to take one semester of Physical Education in middle school every year (Senate Bill 610).
- Enrollment in a dance course will also satisfy the PE requirement.
- If choosing yearlong electives (Art, Band, Theater Beginning Spanish or Chorus) a PE waiver is required.
- Completing a PE waiver does not guarantee that your child will not have PE (waiver may depend upon class space availability).

Team Concept

- Each grade level consists of 3 different teams.
- Each team consists of about 120 students.
- Each team has their own color coded hallway, core classes are next to or across from one another.
- Due to student needs & class sizes, student may be crossed teamed.
- Students will only have to travel far for elective classes, reading classes, & lunch.
- Students have 4 minutes to pass.

Middle School Expectations

• **Daily attendance is critical** to student success.

- Students are expected to use their planner everyday ~ planner checks/quizzes.
- Students are expected to turn in homework.
