I am excited to share that our school will be implementing a new counseling program this school year called “Safer, Smarter Teens.” We were one of the middle schools in Pasco County who have chosen to pilot this important curriculum, which will be expanded to all Pasco County Schools in 2017-18. This is a personal safety curriculum that empowers students to protect themselves in situations where they could be harmed. It is age-appropriate and provides practical strategies to help teens protect themselves without being explicit or frightening. Each year, students will be taught two of the six lessons with a content progression. The activities in the Safer, Smarter Teens program have been designed to meet existing educational standards while imparting critical personal safety information.
