Dear Parents and Guardians,

The 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science classes will ENJOY the wonders of space over the next few months. On Friday, February 23, 2018, the students will explore first hand the NASA Space Complex at the Kennedy Space Center at Cape Canaveral!

We will be leaving school PROMPTLY at 6:30 a.m. and returning back to school about 8:15 p.m. PLEASE be on time in the morning for departure. We WON'T be able to wait if you are late. We are on a strict timetable. No refunds will be given if you miss the bus. Also, please make sure you have a ride available back at school by 8:15 p.m. upon our return.

On arrival to the fabulous Kennedy Space Center, we will tour the entire complex. We will be visiting the various buildings and exhibits. In addition to listening to speakers, seeing the launch pads, and touring the rocket assembly building. They will also have the opportunity to ride the "space flight simulator ride", see an ACTUAL SPACESHUTTLE that went on several missions and many more fun and exciting things! We will be there from approximately 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

### **COST for the Field Trip: \$65.00 each for both students and parents/chaperones.**

The **student special ticket** package price includes the entrance fees for all activities, exhibits, simulated space launch ride, and artifact buildings. The cost also includes the fees for the charter buses. The Nemo Charter Bus lines will provide transportation.

**Included in the student ticket package, students will receive a \$15.00 meal coupon to use at any NASA restaurant for their lunch.** Therefore, students do not need to bring a lunch or get one from the cafeteria. The lunches are included in the price. **Adults will be responsible to purchase their own food on the trip.**

**There are enough spots for 60 students per team to fit on the buses. They will be reserved on a first come, first serve basis. Chaperones will be reserved in the same way. You must be approved district volunteer to be able to have your chaperone spot held to join the field trip.**

**Chaperones responsibilities during the trip include:**

- 1. Being assigned a group of students that they must stay with the entire trip.**
- 2. Make sure your group cleans up their areas at lunch.**
- 3. Chaperones are required to sit with their assigned group on the bus ride there and back.**
- 4. Chaperones are responsible for making sure their assigned students clean up their area of the bus.**

### **Student Eligibility/Safety**

We believe in affording our students the opportunity to participate in rewarding experiences. In order to accomplish our goal, it is necessary to provide a safe and orderly environment. As a result, our administration and staff has developed the following criteria:

Students must meet the individual class, team and administrative guidelines to attend an activity or event. For safety reasons, we may choose to deny attendance to students that have exhibited poor/questionable behavior at any time prior to the trip. This includes any student who receives a referral from December 18, 2017 until the day of the field trip. Students must be on track academically (no Ds or Fs for quarter 2 and 3).

**There will be no refunds granted for any reason after Monday, February 5, 2018.**
