### STATE PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

-Three middle grades or higher courses in English language arts.

-Three middle grades or higher courses in mathematics.

-Three middle grades or higher courses in science.

-Three middle grades or higher courses in social studies.

-One course must be in Civics.

Students must take the EOC and factor in as 30% of their grade.

\*Students must pass all core courses with a D or higher to be eligible for promotion.

### FLORIDA ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS

Students must take the following assessments each year and course placement decisions will be determined based on results of the Florida Standards Assessment in ELA (Grades 6-8), Math (Grades 6-8), and the NGSSS State Science Assessment (Grade 8). Students are required to take the End of Course (EOC) exam for Civics in 7<sup>th</sup> grade and it will be factored in as 30% of their grade. Any student who is in an EOC High School exam course (Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, Algebra 2) must take the EOC.
