Dear MSOL Family,

Florida State Assessment windows will begin in April and run through the end of May. **All students are required to take their assessment on campus**, there is no remote option for the FSA and EOC assessments. Our goal is to help students feel confident, safe, and successful during their testing session. MSOL students will need to be dropped off for their scheduled test session and picked up at the end of their scheduled test session.

Students will be required to be in dress code and must wear a face covering while on campus. Students may choose to bring a snack, water bottle, and a book to read after testing. Students who receive accommodations during exams will be provided with accommodations and may need to contact a parent when the test session is complete for pick up if extended time is permitted.

**ALL MSOL STUDENTS MUST COME ON CAMPUS TO COMPLETE STATE TESTING.** The testing dates for each assessment are listed below with the required testing time and tentative schedule for each testing session. All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will test on the same day due to their tests being paper based. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are being split into 2 rotations due to their tests being computer based and having limited capacity. **Students will receive a confirmed testing schedule with their testing room number the week prior to their scheduled test, which will be posted through myLearning. Students will need to be dropped off in the front of the school and report directly to their testing location no later than 7:20.** Staff will be present to help students find their location.

FSA Writing – Students must sit for 120-minute test session.

FSA Math – Students must sit for 60-minutes for each section 1, 2, and 3

6<sup>th</sup> ALL grade Session 2 and 3 – Thursday May 6<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

7<sup>th</sup> grade Session 2 and 3 – Monday May 10<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Tuesday May 11<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

7<sup>th</sup> grade Advanced Math Session 1-May 17<sup>th</sup> starts at 12:30PM (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)

7<sup>th</sup> grade Advanced Math Session 2 and 3-May 18<sup>th</sup> starts at 10:30AM (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)

8<sup>th</sup> grade Session 1 – Wednesday May 5<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Wednesday May 5<sup>th</sup> starts at 9:30AM

8<sup>th</sup> grade Session 2 and 3 – Thursday May 6<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Friday May 7<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

FSA Reading – Students must sit for 85-minutes for each section 1 and 2

6<sup>th</sup> Session 2 – Tuesday May 4<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

7<sup>th</sup> Session 1 – Wednesday May 12<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Wednesday May 12<sup>th</sup> starts at 9:30AM

7<sup>th</sup> Session 2 – Thursday May 13<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Thursday May 13<sup>th</sup> starts at 9:30AM

8<sup>th</sup> Session 1 – Monday May 3<sup>rd</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Monday May 3<sup>rd</sup> starts at 9:30AM

8<sup>th</sup> Session 2 – Tuesday May 4<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM or Tuesday May 4<sup>th</sup> starts at 9:30AM

FCAT Science –ALL 8<sup>th</sup> grade students AND 7<sup>th</sup> grade ACCELERATED science students must sit for 80-Minutes for each section 1 and 2. For a total of 160 minutes.

Session 1 and 2 – Friday May 14<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

Algebra EOC – Students must sit for 90-minutes each session 1 and 2 but may use up to ½ school day

Algebra Students Session 1 – May 17<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

Algebra Students Session 2 –May 18<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30Am

· Students who use extra time will have to notify parents of later pickup time.

Civics EOC – Students must sit for 80-minute session but may use up to 1 whole school day

½ of 7<sup>th</sup> grade and 8<sup>th</sup> graders taking Civics-May 19<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

½ of 7<sup>th</sup> grade-May 20<sup>th</sup> starts at 7:30AM

· Students who use extra time will have to notify parents of later pickup time.

All students dropped off at 7:10 may report to the cafeteria to pick up a free breakfast prior to testing. Students who are on campus for an extended period (due to length of test or provided accommodations) will be provided lunch or may bring a lunch from home.
