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#### 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE REQUIRED ASSESSMENTS

The state mandate **(F.S. 1003.4156)** requires that middle school students complete a Language Arts, Math, Science, & Social Studies course each year with a minimum grade of "D" as well as a career component through Naviance to be promoted to high school. Middle School students must also sit for the State Civics Assessment.

All 8<sup>th</sup> Graders will take the following assessments:

- FAST ELA Progress Monitoring (3x per year)
- FAST 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math (3x per year) or BEST Algebra I EOC or BEST Geometry I EOC
- NGSSS FCAT 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Science (unless already took in 7<sup>th</sup> grade Accl. Science)
- Civics EOC (if an 8<sup>th</sup> grader enrolled in Civics for 23-24)
- District End-of-Course Final Exams
- Career Component

#### GRADVENTURE-MAY 5TH

## SAVE THE DATES: END OF YEAR 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Activities

8<sup>th</sup> graders wishing to participate in the end of year activities must meet eligibility requirements and pay the \$30 activity fee. Any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who does not pass their current courses and/or fails to complete any course recovery from 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grade will be ineligible to participate in any 8<sup>th</sup> grade end of year activities (4<sup>th</sup> quarter), because he/she would not have met the mandatory requirements for promotion to high school. All final decisions on academic eligibility for end of year activities will be determined by administration and will be based on students meeting promotion guidelines.
